#### Join In The Fun

Taking place on 2 – 4 December, this year's National Cherry Festival celebrates the arrival of Young's most precious crop and will see many visitors and cherry harvest workers converge on the town over the three days.

Young offers a very warm welcome to all visitors to come and celebrate the 62nd National Cherry Festival. Local businesses continue to support the National Cherry Festival and with extensive interest and bookings to date, we're confident the event will attract many visitors.

The theme for the 2011 festival is '150 years Young', acknowledging the anniversary of the town's name change from Lambing Flat to Young. The three day festival will include many key events including the Celtic Tattoo Spectacular, Freestyle Moto Cross Display, the Cherry Festival Ball, National Cherry Festival Street Parade, cherry pip spitting competition, cherry pie eating championships, Hilltops Wine Expo, the Cherry Festival Carnival, live music, fireworks, and much more.

#### Who Can Take Part?

Local businesses, community based organizations, marching bands, schools, educational institutions, classic car clubs, religious organizations and social and hobby groups from Young Shire are encouraged to apply. Other groups considered by application.

#### How To Enter

- Read Terms and Conditions document and sign completed **Application Form**
- Attach copy of your current **Public Liability Insurance**
- Attach completed **Risk Assessment Form**. **Provision of a risk assessment is optional however entrants are encouraged to submit one. Please refer to further information attached.**
- **Return your Application Form by Friday 25 November 2011**
- Any changes to your application must be submitted in writing to the National Cherry Festival Committee
- On the day of the parade, you will receive further instructions and your parade number

## Terms and Conditions of Entry

1. All participants must hold a current \$10 million public liability insurance policy and must identify Young Shire Council (YSC) as an interested party. A certificate of currency must be submitted with Entry Form (The Certificate of Currency must be issued by your insurer not broker).
2. All participants agree to indemnify YSC against all claims, suits, actions or demands which may result in any injury or other loss sustained by you/anyone participating in the Woolworths Cherry Festival Street Parade 2011.
3. All participants agree to indemnify and hold harmless YSC in the event of any claim for loss, damage or otherwise by any person.
4. YSC does not accept responsibility for any damage or loss for your business/property or participants.
5. Participants are to ensure displays are firmly secured in the event of wind/inclement weather.

## Parade Terms and Conditions

1. All participants are responsible for their own personal safety and security. Personal belongings must be in a secure place. All parade entrants should carry water and sun protection.
2. All vehicles must be roadworthy, registered with compliant greenslips or appropriate permit. Every care should be taken to ensure the safety of public and every person travelling on or in the vehicle.
3. All entries must continue in a forward motion through the parade route. Entries must not stop or cause delay. The instructions of Young Shire Council, SES Traffic Controllers and NSW Police must be obeyed. Parade participants must adhere to the parade route and keep within parade time frames. Failure to comply with instructions by officials could result in removal from the parade and exclusion in future parades
4. Entries must proceed in the order designated by the Parade organiser.
5. Animals are subject to terms and conditions.
6. Participants are reminded that this event takes place in a designated Alcohol Free Zone and alcohol is not permitted.
7. Floats carrying participants must have appropriate safety rails/restraints fitted.
8. Children participating in parade must be accompanied and under the direct supervision of a responsible adult **at all times**.
9. Photographs/film may be taken and used by the National Cherry Festival, the media and others to publicly promote the events.
10. Suitably experienced adults must accompany animals at all times and will be deemed responsible for the animal and crowd safety during the parade and marshalling. Entrants are responsible for collecting animal waste before, during and after the parade. The National Cherry Festival reserves the right to assess and/or refuse the involvement of animals on a case by case basis.
11. Entrants are not permitted to distribute or throw giveaways directly from the vehicle/float. Entrants may hand out giveaways from person to person on foot while on the parade route.
12. The use of fireworks, crackers, sparklers or other pyrotechnics, sirens or water pistols at any time during marshalling or the parade is discouraged (with the exception of emergency vehicles).
13. The National Cherry Festival and YSC reserves the right to exclude any group, individual or organisation from participating in the parade.

**Failure to comply with terms and conditions may result in removal from the event and exclusion in future years.**

### Parade Information

- Time:** Parade commences at 4.00pm
- Theme:** 150 years Young
- Assembly Point:** Cnr Calabash and Cloete St
- Assembly Time:** From 3.00pm all participants must be in place by 3.45pm
- Route:** West along Boorowa Street, parade route ends at the intersection of Clarke and Boorowa Streets.
- Parade Exit:** There are two exit points for parade participants, either continue along Boorowa Street or turn right into Clarke St.
- Float drop off point:** Walking participants exit via Clarke St. Floats exit via Boorowa St. **Please ensure that persons riding on floats disembark in the block between Clarke and Thornhill Sts. No vehicles shall travel beyond the Thornhill St roundabout with participants still onboard. This will be monitored by the Police (who will take action) and Marshalls.**
